## 1. Management Report.

- Opening of Ninth hole LX and the back nine LX delayed due to the bad weather experienced, excess water and particularly low ground temperatures delaying growth.
- Work on LX 12 left till the autumn.
- Driving range project now starting, exciting improvements to be made.
- No maintenance in August (LIV Tour event) moved to October for both courses.
- Slope on BH 10<sup>th</sup> plans being formulated to help with ball running down and off to the left.
- Data Breach Foxhills DPO checking all Systems Golf Genius found to be secure. No news nor plans to remove Golf only category from Foxhills memberships.
- Divoting team restarted, their much appreciated, efforts.
- Greens Committee type communication with Club Committee in need of strengthening. Regular dialogue with Course Manager being encouraged.
- Brief LIV update.

#### 2. Captain.

- Don McIntosh is away no report.
- New rules (1st April an apt date) additional actions required. Discussion/plans. Introduction of boards and the use of QR codes.
- Discussion regarding the ladies playing the Goldberg of the Gold tees was had. We would run a separate gold tee comp for ladies. If successful this year future committees could look to make permanent with its own trophy.
- Ladies were encouraged to play off tees other than the greens.
- New handicap tables for display on both first tees in train. SG/IH.
- Trophies (engraving update and new pairs plate). SdB to report back and source, multitude of suggestions including glass (best in avoiding theft/reduction in insurance premiums). Budget of £150
- Hibby Competition to be pushed still further, fee now £20 for food and prizes.
- Handicap Secretaries review of the year Mike and Sarah have proposed a minimum of 4 comp cards, in the last calendar year, for Board comps as they have limited control to adjust people who have entered 3/4 general play cards.
- Summer knock outs set up Golf Services to action.
- Golf Services to issue instructions to members playing in competitions in a more timely manner. There have been some issues and confusion caused by late receipt of instructions. Some member complaints received.
- Mens and ladies matches (review and tee time bookings)
- Golf Charity Ball going ahead. Captain and Golf Services planning and scheduling. 19<sup>th</sup> July tickets on sale soon.
- Hayton Cup to be organised. IH
- New Menu for committee use. Produce and share. EL/Golf Services/Chef.
- Womens Club swap was discussed. Detail and possible roll out across the club, other areas, (ensuring inclusiveness) referred to. The Seniors have in the past organised a couple of these type events with Moor Park - they worked very well, they were liked and attended. Deemed a good idea.

- Captain made a couple of pleas for "One meeting." Calling committee members to order both times. Committee members are asked to ensure that their enthusiasm and concentration is focussed on the agenda items as Chaired by the Captain.
- Continuous review of Competitions manual noted. Latest version on G-drive. During an impromptu democratic vote on whether 3 clubs and a putter should be in the All Winners Day eligibility criteria the Captain suggested the Director of Golf didn't have a vote but the Vice Captain correctly pointed out that in his capacity as delegate of the Club President he did. The Captain apologised. SG elected not to vote. It was decided it (3clubs and a putter) should not be included primarily as it is a non qualifier.
- Introduction of a physical Captains board detailing contemporary detail was discussed. This is to run alongside the popular digital contacts, email updates for instance.

## THE WALLIS TROPHY - TEAM CAPTAIN - ORLA SWEENEY

Team of 5 x single matches for ladies with a Handicap Index between 21.0 - 36.0 55 teams have entered the competition and Foxhills have been drawn against Chipstead in the preliminary round, with the away match arranged for Monday 8th April and the home match on Thursday 11th. We have a squad of 15 but some ladies don't have enough qualifying cards (3) which is hampering the team selection and we would like more higher handicap ladies to be part in the squad.

## 5. Any other business.

• Concern that nearest to the pin in 2 competitions - when applied to mixed field are inequitable was mentioned. Difference in driving distance between lady and men members was suggested to be the reason it being "unfair." Complaints were received from some ladies. Research suggests that the average driving distance for women (all ages and abilities) is slightly under 160 yards, the average (all ages and abilities) for men slightly over 220 yards, an obvious issue. Suggestion is that going forward there are two competitions, of this type, one for each gender.
